### Programme détaillé

**10h30 : Visite guidée du Musée des Impressionnistes Giverny"**

To mark its tenth anniversary, the musée des impressionnistes Giverny has decided to celebrate the work of Claude Monet by comparing it with that of his contemporary, the Symbolist painter Jean-François Auburtin (1866-1930). After discovering Monet's work on display in Paris, Auburtin chose to follow in the master's footsteps. From Belle-Île ans Etretat

Deux expositions d'envergure to Pourville, Varengeville an Provence, he began indefatigably painting the magnificent beauty of these sites. The exhibition brings together a large selection of Auburtin's paintings and drawings, together with several of Monet's most remarkable works with the aim of presenting two different visions of the same landscapes.

**14h00 : Welcome to the world of the painter and graderner Claude Monet. For over 40 years, until his death in 1926, Giverny was his home, his site of creation and his masterpiece. A world of senses, of colors and of memories, the house in which the artist and his family lived notably contains his studio-sitting room and his exceptional collection of Japanese prints. The gardens are composed of the Clos Normand, with its flowerbeds, and the water garden, planted with oriental vegetation and weeping willows, its Japanese bridge painted green and its water lilies.**
